



Patrick "Joe" Driscoll,

a Manalapan resident for 35 years, was killed on September 11th, 2001, aboard United Airlines Flight #93 in the attack on America. A great athlete and outdoorsman, Joe was heading

to Yosemite National Park in California for his annual hiking trip when terrorists hijacked Flight # 93.

Joe and his wife Maureen were looking forward to celebrating their 44th wedding anniversary that year. He was a father of four children and had five grandchildren. As a member of the US Navy, Joe served on the USS Power during the Korean War. He graduated first in his class from the New York University School of Engineering and earned a Master's Degree in Computer Science from Rutgers University. Joe retired from Bellcore as Executive Director of Software Development. As a member of The Yorktowne Club, a community benevolent organization located in Manalapan, Joe spent countless hours coaching sports, teaching and giving back to his community. As many of his family and friends have come to say, "Joe lived as a hero. It is no surprise he died as one." Help us honor Joe and carry on the giving he did so freely. 


Patrick "Joe" Driscoll,

comfort to their families.

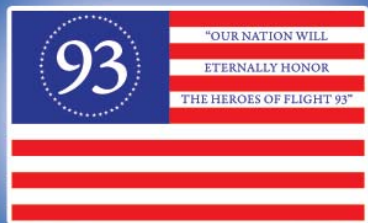

In 2002, in response to the devastating 9/11 terrorist attacks on our great nation, a number of civic volunteers undertook a fund raising project and initiated a community walk through Monmouth Battlefield State Park as a tribute to one of our friends and neighbors, Patrick "Joe" Driscoll, who perished that day on Flight 93. This annual day of remembrance and healing known as the "Walk with Joe" is eagerly anticipated and supported by many local residents.

We are a 501(c)(3) event with all of the proceeds from the walk, including monies raised from participants and sponsors, donated to numerous charities. Organizations which have benefited include: The Samaritan Center food bank, The Freehold Open Door food bank, The Monmouth County Child Advocacy Center, American Recreational Military Services (ARMS), Monmouth Battlefield State Park, the RJM Foundation (a special needs youth organization), The Flight 93 National Memorial in Shanksville PA, The Monmouth County Mount Mitchell Memorial Park, The University of West Virginia Christopher Gray Memorial Scholarship Fund, youth athletic programs, Hurricane Katrina relief efforts, and numerous non-profit organizations serving the area with humanitarian aid and programs.



The Annual "Walk with Joe" event has grown beyond a local tribute and has become one of the most significant 9/11 memorial activities in Monmouth County. Since the inception of the walk, there have been over 5,000 participants. The theme "**we will never forget**" becomes more applicable with each passing year.

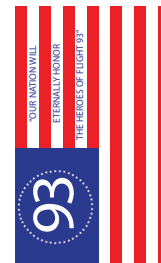
